Maha Vinayaka Chaturthi Celebrations Thursday, 13th September 2018

Time: 8am - 8pm



Although Vinayaka Chaturthi fasting is done every month the most significant Maha Vinayaka Chaturthi falls in the month of August/September. The Chaturthi Tithi during August/September month is known as **Maha Ganesha Chaturthi**. Maha Ganesha Chaturthi is celebrated by Hindus all over the world as the birthday of Lord Ganesha.

This Vinayakar Chaturthi is also known as Varad Vinayaka Chaturthi. Varad means "asking Lord Ganesha to fulfil any desire one has". Lord Ganesha blesses devotees who observe this fast with wisdom and patience.

The special ceremonies on this day will begin at 8am at the main temple and will be conducted by Chief Priest Sivaargamaratnam ShivaSri Ratnaprabakara Kurrukal, Shiva Agama Pooshanam Janakiraman Kurrukal and other distinguished priests.

The programs:-

8.00am – 10.00am Ganapathi Vethamanthira, Moolamanthira Homa and Abhishekam.

10:00am – 10:30am Vasanthamandapa Aarathi and Punchamugavinayaka procession to Karpaga Vinayaka at the entrance of temple, where Lord Vinayaka is sculptured in 16 different forms and gracing the devotees.

11:30am – 5:30pm Continuous Karpaga Vinayaka Homa, Milk Abesergam, offering of Mothaga Prasatham, individual Poorahuthi followed by main Poorahuthi.

6:00pm – Karpaga Vinayaka Archana and Deepa-Arathi



6:30pm - Punchamuga Vinayaka ceremonial Procession to immersion of Lord Ganesha into the temple pond (Tirthas).

8:00pm – Punchamuga Vinayaka Procession conclude at the main Temple, followed by Prasadam.
